Dear Eastman Golf Links Members,

This package contains the all-important 2017 EGL Membership Application and related information. Renewing or initiating your EGL Membership early in the year is very important because it sets the tone for the entire season and helps us in our planning. To that end, we encourage you to sign up no later than March 31, 2017, because there is a 10% surcharge for applications received after that date.

EGL is the best golf membership value in the area, enabling Members to play a championship golf course and enjoy the many benefits that Eastman has to offer. In 2017, EGL Members will enjoy the following major improvements pending Board approval of the budget in mid-February.

- **New Electric Cart Fleet**

The current fleet of 50 carts will be replaced with electric carts. The new, environmentally friendly fleet will reduce noise, emissions and maintenance. Other features that will improve the golfing experience are USB charging ports and auto braking. Daily cart rates will increase slightly; the seasonal cart rate for an individual will remain the same; the dual option will be \$100.00 less than last year.

- **Development of the Forward Tee Program**

The recently completed Master Plan identified specific golf course modifications to improve playability and maintain the overall health of the course. The capital spending request that is currently under consideration will provide for the construction of additional forward tees.

- **Golf Course Condition**

Everyone loved the condition of the greens last season. We are committed to that same high standard for the 2017 season. Also, new mats for the driving range are being purchased.

Yes, 2017 will be a great year for golf at Eastman Golf Links. We look forward to a full season in the new Center. Eastman and everyone involved with the golfing experience have made a significant commitment to the enjoyment of EGL Members. We thank you in advance for your membership and look forward to bringing a wonderful season of golf to you.

PAYMENT OPTIONS—

Payments must be received at the ECA Office by March 31 to be eligible for the following options.

- **Make a payment of 33%** of your membership fee (*for Gold, Platinum, and Family Memberships only*) by March 31 and pay the remainder in two equal payments—billed in April and May.
- **Make full payment by March 31** to use a VISA, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover card. **Does not** include ECA Charge.
- **Membership and Player Pass rates increase by 10% after March 31, 2017.** Amounts are in parentheses.

Payment may be made by check, cash, or credit cards as defined above.

THREE-MONTH PAYMENT PLAN

Family, Platinum, and Gold Membership levels can be paid over a 3-month period. By March 31, 2017, one-third of membership is due, payable by check, and the remaining 2 payments will be billed on your ECA account for the months of April and May. Commercial credit cards are not acceptable for this payment plan.

However, VISA, MasterCard, and American Express cards may be used for full payment by March 31, 2017.

ADDITIONAL MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Junior Membership—For anyone under the age of 18 as of April 1, 2017. Play anytime after 2 p.m. seven days a week. The Golf Shop has the discretion to require an adult to accompany a junior and to allow earlier play.

Student Membership—A full-time student is an individual attending college or other post-secondary educational institution up to the age of 25 as of April 1, 2017. Students may play seven days a week.

SEASON CART PASS

A cart pass for unlimited cart use is available and must be paid in full with the membership dues.

- Single cart pass is \$650 for Platinum Memberships.
- Dual cart pass is \$1,100 for two designated drivers with a Family Membership.

RICHARD D. MCDONOUGH GOLF SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

The McDonough Scholarship Fund was established in 1955 to grant scholarships to any employee, male or female, of a New Hampshire golf course. Since its inception, the McDonough Foundation has awarded over \$2 million in scholarships. The greatest source of revenue comes from contributions from New Hampshire golfers during the annual bag-tag promotion.

Eastman golfers should be highly motivated to do their share. Eastman's Chief Maintenance Officer Mike Gornert is a McDonough recipient. Other recipients include Mark Larrabee's son, Eric; Shawn McClory, who worked as a ranger 2011-2013; the son of EGL member Jeff Rounsaville; and Ellen Lamson, who worked in the Golf Shop in 2005 and 2006. When competing for students to work summers on the course or in the Golf Shop, offering eligibility for a scholarship may help in hiring the prospects we want.
